Margaret Kralt is a Planner with Dillon Consulting, with over 7 years of experience in First Nation planning and research both at a community and regional level. She has worked with communities throughout the Northwest Territories providing professional support for Traditional Knowledge Studies, community capacity development initiatives, planning and design, community consultation, key stakeholder interviews and workshop facilitation.

Both presenters have worked together to re-establish APPI's Northern Events Committee and are working to bring continuous professional learning to planners in isolated communities. This is their opportunity to showcase the challenges, opportunities, and projects that have been going on in the North.
