Submissions are restricted to the following items and must be provided in one pdf file via email to the APPI office at admin@albertaplanners.com with the file name: FirstInitialLastNameEducationSch for example: VHACKLEDUCATIONSCH

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. The most recent university transcript or student record.
- 3. A curriculum vitae or resume outlining your background and involvement in planning related activities or organizations including volunteer experience (in any sector).
- 4. A written submission (no more than 500 words) consisting of the following:
  - an outline of the intended use of this monetary scholarship; •
    - an expression of financial need; and, •
    - a brief description of: •
      - a. your interest in research, emerging practices and innovation in the advancement of excellence in planning;
      - how your interests described above contribute to the practice of planning in b. Alberta, Northwest Territories or Nunavut.

All four of the submission requirements will be weighted equally in the evaluation of scholarship submissions.
