Responsibilities:

Long Range Planning

- Develop and write policies and bylaws through comprehensive research and consultation with a broad range of stakeholders.

- Conduct research on planning and related issues.
- Provide review and comment on subdivision applications.
- Consult with relevant stakeholders on new or changing policy and bylaw outcomes.
- Prepare draft bylaws and other planning documents and reports.
- Process bylaws to meet legislative requirements and amendment procedures.
- Communicate the City's goals and intent behind proposals to a variety of stakeholders and the public.
- Prepare and present Request for Decision (RFD) and other finding to Council and Committee of the Whole.
- Follow project management methodology and processes on projects.

Intermunicipal Planning

- Managing and commenting on intermunicipal referrals and issues.
- Represent the City as required for intermunicipal land use matters.

Qualifications:

- Post secondary Degree in Urban or Regional Planning, related field of studies or equivalent.
- Masters Degree an asset.
- Minimum seven (7) years directly related experience, preferably in a public sector environment setting.
- Demonstrated experience in long range planning.
