- Sound knowledge of research techniques and methodology and of the current trends and developments in urban planning plus demonstrated ability to collect, analyze and interpret data and submit conclusions and recommendations;
- Ability to prepare reports and recommendations on a variety of planning projects, programs and policies, to communicate effectively and to explain technical concepts and plans;
- Ability to direct the work of technical staff;
- Ability to work collaboratively with others and to make a positive contribution to a team environment;
- Possess and maintain a valid BC Class 5 driver's license with a demonstrated safe driving record.
