East Village and Victoria Park: A Master Planned District

Join Susan Veres of the Calgary Municipal Land Corporation, Calgary Neighbourhoods and APPI members for a presentation on the future of a Master Planned District including East Village and Victoria Park. As Senior VP Strategy & Business Development, Susan has played key roles both in stewarding current CMLC projects and in evaluating and securing future opportunities that fit with the organization's mandate and capabilities. Gifted with foresight and big picture thinking, Susan has been integral in crafting a long-term strategic vision for the company, ensuring the organization is well positioned for future growth, and uncovering new and rewarding ways to put the CMLC team's considerable talents as developers and placemakers to very good use.

CMLC is an independent development company created by the City of Calgary in 2007 to advance the City's objectives for urban diversification, community renewal, infrastructure investment and placemaking. They make neighborhoods more livable – plan and develop new infrastructure, connectivity, public art, programming, places to live, retail and other elements of a true community. Starting in East Village, CMLC is now expanding their presence to new communities including Calgary's future Entertainment District. Since delivery of the East Village Master Plan began ten years ago, CMLC has attracted over \$3 billion in planned investment to the neighbourhood. When East Village is built out, the investment will generate approximately \$40 million in annual tax revenue for the City of Calgary and the Province of Alberta.
