The award is to provide financial assistance with the applicant's expenses related to attendance and participation at the approved conference and will be awarded prior to the conference.

This award will be evaluated based on the entirety of the application and overall merit and not judged on academics. A maximum of two (2) \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded for 2026. One award will be given to an Undergraduate degree student, and one award will be given to a Master's degree student.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students who are entering or enrolled in a diploma, degree, or an undergraduate, master's, or PhD degree program at a post-secondary institution in Alberta, Northwest Territories, or Nunavut, including but not limited to students completing their final year in 2026, are eligible to apply.
- Students may be enrolled in an accredited planning program, an unaccredited planning program, or a planning related field of study such as: urban, rural, environmental recreation, land use, or another program of study or design.
- Student applicants do not have to be APPI Student members to apply for these awards.
- Submissions will be evaluated on an equally weighted basis, on creativity, financial need and relevance to the Alberta, Northwest Territories or Nunavut jurisdiction.
