 Students must be entering or enrolled in an undergraduate or master's or PhD degree program at a post-secondary institution in Alberta, Northwest Territories, or Nunavut. Students completing their final year in 2026 are eligible to apply. Students may be enrolled in an accredited planning program, an unaccredited planning program, or a planning related field of study such as: urban, rural, environmental recreation, land use, or another program of study or design. Student applicants do not have to be APPI Student members to apply for these awards. Submissions will be evaluated on an equally weighted basis, on creativity, financial need and relevance to the Alberta, Northwest Territories or Nunavut jurisdiction.
