APPI is pleased to announce the recipient of the 2016 Outstanding Contribution to the Profession Award, Gary Willson, RPP, MCIP.

Gary acquired an undergraduate degree in Urban Geography from the University of British Columbia in 1971 and then a graduate degree in Urbanism from the Faculty of Environmental Design at the University of Calgary in 1976.
