APPI Planning Awards

Each year the Alberta Professional Planners Institute recognizes exceptional plans and projects, undertaken in whole or in part by members of the Institute, that significantly contribute to the livability of communities in Alberta, the Northwest Territories and Nunavut. Exceptional planning goes well above and beyond good planning practice. Good planning is expected of all regulated APPI members. Only exceptional planning warrants award consideration. Plans and projects specific to rural and indigenous planning are encouraged.

Applicants are applying for an award recognizing exceptional planning. The Planning Awards Committee determines the standing of all applications and if they qualify to be a Certificate of Planning Excellence, a Certificate of Planning Merit or whether no award will be granted. There will not be a maximum or minimum number for either type of award given.

The awards will be presented at the 2026 APPI Conference in Calgary, Monday, September 28th during the evening Awards Banquet.
