Things to know while logging your CPL

As a regulated member who self-reports your Continuous Professional Learning (CPL), which is due yearly by December 31st, that:

- Candidates preparing for RPP certification may not log as CPL LUs, time preparing, studying or writing the Ethics & Professionalism Course or the Professional Examination, or time spent being mentored. Mentors and Sponsors of Candidate members may log the time they spend serving as a mentor and/or sponsor of a Candidate member.
- Members must ensure entries for their time allotted to preparation, research, etc. is not part of their normal day-to-day compensated professional work, but rather independent professional learning in furthering their knowledge, understanding, skills and abilities relevant to the theory, methods, and practice of planning.
- Members must enter each course taken as part of a full course or program, and identify the specific hours, event type and category for each course.
- Members may log LUs for time spent volunteering on boards or committees, however, this volunteer time must not be recorded as one entry for the entire year, rather each meeting or volunteer commitment should be separately logged.
- Members must enter the Provider/Author of each event.
- Members are responsible for ensuring that if they have participated in a conference, webinar, etc. through APPI, CIP, or another PTIA, that the same entry was not already uploaded on their behalf by the provider, to avoid the duplicate entry of CPL LUs.
- Members must ensure that the LUs being entered are correctly identified as either structured or unstructured, and that they annually meet the minimum requirement of 9 structured LUs. If unsure, consult the [CPL Guide](#) for clarification and examples.
