- Reputational Management
- Extended Reporting Coverage for Retired Members, or Members that Discontinue Professional Practice

APPI members also have access to additional coverages: Commercial General Liability, Legal Entity, Cyber Security & Privacy Liability, Employment Practices Liability, Legal Expense Insurance, 24 Hours Accident Insurance, Critical Illness, Family Cyber Coverage and Emergency Medical Travel Insurance.
