This includes all current community planning, subdivision, and development approvals, as well as assisting the CAO and the senior leadership team to support economic and strategic growth within the region as set out by the Council. There are four direct reports to the Director (Senior Planner, two Development Officers, and the Planning Administrative Assistant).
