- A member or is a candidate/student member of APPI (or another provincial/regional equivalent) and CIP;
- Familiar with the *Municipal Government Act*, and other provincial legislation;
- Familiar with long range plans (intermunicipal development plans and municipal development plans) and land use bylaws;
- Experienced preparing reports for subdivision and development permit applications;

- Able to work within irregular and fast-paced timeframes;
