Rocky View County's diverse communities are continuing to grow, and our Planning department is working with our new Council to reassess its growth strategy against the backdrop of the Calgary Metropolitan Region Board. This brings an incredible opportunity for enthusiastic Planners to work on a number of projects to prepare, review and implement County-wide and community-level Planning documents.

As a result of an expanding workplan, a realignment of the department has resulted in three new Planner positions that will be placed between our Planning Policy and Planning and Development teams.

As one of our Planners, you continually have the opportunity to work independently on files or collaboratively on project teams, as the situation dictates. Presentations to Council, Boards and Committees are an integral component of the scope of duties. The more intermediate to senior-level Planners will act as a resource and mentor for more junior colleagues as well as other department employees.

These positions will often have you taking a lead role in the review of planning and development applications, development of planning strategies, statutory documents and municipal policy. You will also be expected to handle a wide range of duties related to all manner and size of projects, policies, applications and operations of each of the Planning teams. You will need to nurture and maintain working relationships dealing with our many municipal partners, while advancing the interests of the County.

Core Accountabilities:

- continuous interactions with the general public through front counter, telephone, and written inquiries;
- review, process and manage local plans, redesignation, and subdivision files for compliance to policy, regulations, and technical requirements;
- prepare and present reports to Council, County Committees, and to appeal boards as required;
- assist in the preparation of concept plans within approved policy plans or limited scope conceptual schemes;
- assist identification of municipal, community or intermunicipal issues and opportunities that could be mitigated through better community planning;
- Review and respond to referrals from internal departments and government agencies

Position Requirements:

- Completion of Bachelor's Degree in Planning along with progressively responsible and diversified experience in Municipal Planning environment.
- excellent communication and judgment skills; organizational and time management; facilitation, negotiation and mediation; presentation and written skills;
 - thorough understanding of rural, urban and regional planning, related regulatory environment;
 - ability to relate strategic planning initiatives to policy implementation;
 - excellent project management skills, particularly within complex, high profile, large-scale, or time-sensitive projects;
 - awareness and sensitivity towards economic and political environment and impacts on planning environment;
 - able to deal with co-workers and the public in a positive, facilitative, and pleasant manner.
