### **Planning Assistant (One position, 1-year temporary)**

**Salary:** \$32.13 – \$37.75 / Hour

Reporting to the Supervisor Planning and Development, the Planning Assistant is responsible for a variety of planning, development and office support work and providing general information to internal customers and the public on a range of technical and procedural matters relating to development permits and planning applications.

### **Planner 1 (One position, 2-year temporary)**

**Salary:** \$39.28 - \$46.15 / Hour

This is an entry level professional Planning position that requires a high degree of professional responsibility in the development and implementation of planning strategies, statutory documents, and municipal policy. The position also requires a thorough knowledge of related Acts and Regulations and the planning process in Alberta. The Planner primarily works under immediate supervision preparing submissions to Council.

### **Planner 2 (One position, 2-year temporary)**

**Salary:** \$44.53 – \$52.33 / Hour

This is a mid-level professional Planning position that requires a high degree of professional responsibility in the development and implementation of planning strategies, statutory documents, and municipal policy. The position also requires a thorough knowledge of related Acts and Regulations and the planning process in Alberta. The Planner primarily works independently and prepares submissions to Council.
