Planner

The Planner plays a vital supporting role within the Planning & Development Department, working under the guidance and mentorship of the Planning & Development Manager. This entry-level position is designed to assist in both current and long-range planning initiatives that contribute to the sustainable growth and orderly development of the Town of Blackfalds.

As a key member of the team, provides foundational planning support by conducting research, preparing reports, and assisting in the review and development of Statutory and non-Statutory Plans, Land Use Bylaw amendments, and subdivision applications. The role involves applying established planning principles and best practices while learning to interpret and implement the Municipal Government Act and other relevant provincial regulations.

This position offers an excellent opportunity for a motivated individual to gain hands-on experience in municipal planning, develop professional competencies, and contribute meaningfully to the Town's long-term vision. Works collaboratively with internal departments, external stakeholders, and the public, ensuring planning decisions are informed, consistent, and aligned with community goals.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Familiarity with Alberta's Municipal Government Act and planning regulations.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and ability to learn new digital tools.
- Strong analytical, organizational, and communication skills, both written and verbal, including report writing and presentations.

- Knowledge of Alberta's planning and development regulations, including the Municipal Government Act and related legislation.
- Ability to develop expertise across all areas of municipal planning.
