The June 2013 water event provided the Town of High River with an enormous opportunity for the development of long-term solutions, ensuring that the economic and cultural vitality of High River is not only restored, but improved and reenergized. The Downtown Area Redevelopment Plan introduced a strategy for recovery and revitalization.

Despite the massive destruction, rebuilding the downtown provided an opportunity to address flood risks while improving the area - an opportunity to re-imagine downtown and rebuild it to meet the needs of businesses, residents and visitors.
