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SESSION FORMATS

The conference program will include a mix of workshops, concurrent sessions, and learning tours designed to appeal to a range of learning styles. Proposals for interactive sessions are highly encouraged.

Deep Dive Sessions

Intense and richer conversations and exploration of topics which are 1-2 hours in length, including 15-20 minutes for questions and discussion. This category may include panel discussions, inspiring presentations, or workshops conducted within the conference venue.

Guided Experiential Activities

Hands-on sessions that may include an outing in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo region (2-8 hours including travel time).

Learning Tour

Activity which takes place offsite, and may be by bus, or on foot, or other self-propelled form, and visit one or more sites.

Fast, Funny, and Passionate

Capture planning in today's world by giving a 10 minute presentation that is funny and makes people think.

Idea Lab and Facilitated Conversations

Workshop style sessions that are highly interactive. A short, informative component followed by group interaction that fosters interactive and collaborative idea-growing.

Sessions or demonstrations from presenters who are with companies that will be/are sponsoring the APPI 2019 conference have an exhibit space. Please indicate in your application if you qualify as a sponsor presenter. **Examples** of potential conference topics include (but are of course not limited to) ...

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of presentations will be based on the following:

- Relevance to Conference Theme (Celebrate Strength)
- Consistency with the submission criteria, as listed
- Overall quality, creativity, and applicability of the session/ tour/activity to a wide range of planning professionals
- Presenter's expertise, knowledge, and ability to engage and challenge delegates

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WHAT TO INCLUDE WHEN SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL

- 1. Title of presentation (the catchier, the better limit of 200 characters)
- 2. Name, company and contact information for primary contact (telephone number and email address)
- **3. Proposed presentation format** (be specific on type and length)
- 4. Summary (in 200 words or less, outline the content of your presentation and how it relates to the theme of Celebrate Strength. Identify key takeaways, include very brief biographic information for each presenter, and be specific on why attendees should choose your session. This summary will appear in the official conference program)
- 5. Specialized equipment requirements

All submissions will be acknowledged and sent a confirmation email within a week of receipt. Prospective presenters will be informed of the status of their proposal by March 31, 2019.

All successful presenters will be sent a Speaker Contract, AV Requirement Form, and a Speaker Registration Form following confirmation of their presentation being selected.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Audio / Visual: All session rooms will be equipped with a projector, laptop, screen, podium, wireless mic and one hand held wireless mic. The session rooms are typical set up with round tables or only chairs depending on the size of the space. Additional AV equipment may be available upon request, such as direct internet connection or other specialized equipment at the presenter's expense.

Handouts: All printed materials are to be prepared and provided at the presenter's own expense.

Conference registration: A discounted conference registration rate, equivalent to 80% of the member early bird rate, will be offered to the presenters. Separate priced activities will be at the regular rate. APPI reserves the right to limit the number of presenters on any one panel and/ or who may be eligible for the discounted registration rate. Presenters are responsible for all accommodation and travel expenses.

Communication: All communication concerning this submission will be sent to the primary contact at the email address indicated in the submission.

Tours: Tours will be arranged using local vendors and APPI administration will facilitate all contracts.

Format: The Conference Committee may ask presenters to revise the format for technical and/or feasibility reasons. We advise that any necessary web content for presentations should be downloaded in advance and incorporated in the presentation.
