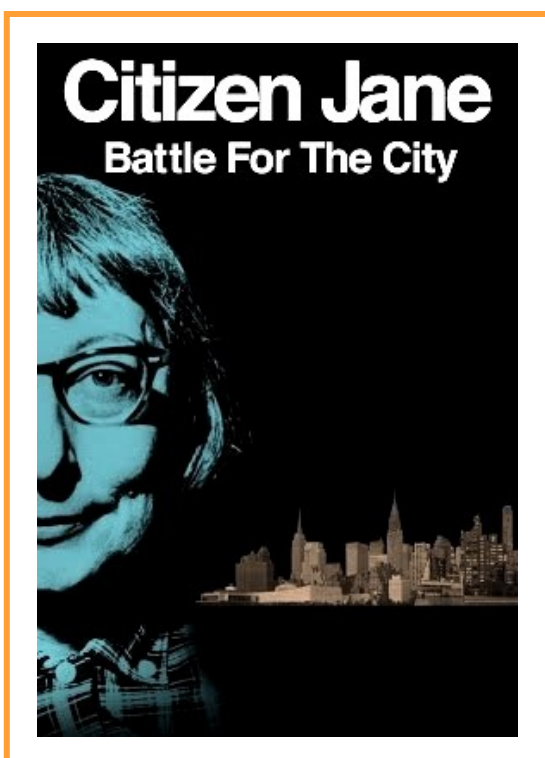


# *Join us for World Town Planning Day!*

World Town Planning Day began in 1949 as an international day celebrating the accomplishments of planners and their contributions to their communities. On November 9, in recognition of Community Planning Worldwide, the Alberta Professional Planners Institute will present the film:

**Citizen Jane: Battle for the City** (92 minutes)

In 1960, Jane Jacobs's book *The Death and Life of Great American Cities* sent shockwaves through the architecture and planning worlds, with its exploration of the consequences of modern planners and architects reconfiguration of cities. This film retraces the battles for the city as a personified by Jacobs and 'master builder' Robert Moses as urbanization moves to the very front of the global agenda.
